

ChargerBox User documentation



1. Description

Intended use

The SmartLiberty ChargerBox is used to charge several smartphones simultaneously and in a space-saving way. The smartphone chargers are connected inside the ChargerBox and are individually interchangeable.

Overview




Fig. 1 ChargerBox, closed

- 5 Ventilation slots




Fig. 2 ChargerBox, opened

2. Use



Danger of overheating if the ventilation slots are covered!

High temperatures can occur inside the ChargerBox.

- ▶ Do not place the ChargerBox in a sunny location.
- ▶ Do not cover the ventilation slots.
- ➤ Do not place the ChargerBox on soft ground.
- ▶ Do not place the ChargerBox in a cupboard.




Fig. 3 Do not cover the ventilation slots (side and top)




Fig. 4 Do not cover the ventilation slots (rear and bottom)

The ChargerBox can remain connected to the power supply before and after charging smartphones.

Charging smartphones

- 1. Connect the smartphone to a free USB cable. If necessary, pull out the USB cable a little.
- 2. Place the smartphone in a free charging slot.
- 3. Observe the charging indicator on the smartphone.

3. Installation

Mounting the ChargerBox

The ChargerBox is delivered without pre-assembled chargers and USB cables.

The chargers and USB cables of the smartphones supplied separately can be used for mounting.

- 1. Open the ChargerBox.

 See «4. Opening/closing the ChargerBox».
- 2. Remove the protection of the double-sided adhesive tape from the plug strip.




Fig. 5 Removing the protection from the adhesive tape

- 3. Glue both plug strips in the ChargerBox. Glue the plug strips offset to each other.
- 4. Plug the connector of one of the two plug strips into the other plug strip.

5. Guide the power cord through the cable entry on the right or left.




Fig. 6 Attaching and connecting plug strips

- 6. Insert the chargers into the plug strips. Plug in a maximum of 10 chargers.
- 7. Collect the USB cable on the left and right side in one strand each and tie together.




Fig. 7 Collecting the USB cable

8. Pull each USB cable through the openings in the cover so that approx. 15 cm protrude.




Fig. 8 Passing the USB cable through the cover

- 9. Make sure that both plug strips are switched on. The on/off switch (7, Fig. 2) is always in the "On" position.
- 10. Close the ChargerBox.

 See «4. Opening/closing the ChargerBox».

Mounting the ChargerBox on the wall

- ► Ensure it is mounted at a suitable height for use.
- ► Ensure that there is a socket nearby.
- 1. Attach the ChargerBox to the wall using 2 screws.




Fig. 9 Holes for attaching to the wall

1 Holes for attaching to the wall




Fig. 10 Mounting the ChargerBox on the wall

2. Plug the power cord into the socket.

Placing the ChargerBox on the table

- 1. Choose a place near a socket.
- 2. Place a non-slip base.
- 3. Place the ChargerBox on the non-slip surface.
- 4. Plug the power cord into the socket.




Fig. 11 Placing the ChargerBox on the table

Connecting several ChargerBoxes (option)

- 1. Disconnect all ChargerBoxes from the power supply.
- 2. Open all ChargerBoxes except the last ChargerBox in the chain.
 - See «4. Opening/closing the ChargerBox».
- 3. Connect the ChargerBoxes to each other:
 - Lead the power cord through the free cable entry of the ChargerBox next to it and connect it to the plug strip.




Fig. 12 Connecting several ChargerBoxes

- 4. Make sure that all plug strips are switched on. The on/off switch (7, Fig. 2) is always in the "On" position.
- 5. Close the ChargerBoxes. See *«4. Opening/closing the ChargerBox».*
- 6. Connect the first ChargerBox in the chain to a power socket.




Fig. 13 Connecting the first ChargerBox

4. Opening/closing the ChargerBox

The ChargerBox must be opened in order to:

- mount the plug strips and chargers
- exchange chargers
- · connect further ChargerBoxes.

Opening the ChargerBox.

- 1. Disconnect the power cord from the socket.
- 2. Unscrew the ChargerBox cover with a Phillips screwdriver.
- 3. Remove both parts of the cover.




Fig. 14 Opening the ChargerBox.

Closing the ChargerBox

1. Make sure that all plug strips are switched on. The on/off switch (7, Fig. 2) is always in the "On" position.



Risk of damage to the cables!

▶ Make sure that no cables are pinched.

- 2. Hold any cable to the side and put on the cover.
- i To make it easier to insert the screws, place the cover flush on the housing.
- 3. Insert the screws.
- 4. Tighten the screws with a Phillips screwdriver.




Fig. 15 Closing the ChargerBox

5. Replacing chargers

The ChargerBox is designed so that it will continue to function if a charger becomes defective and only the charger in question needs to be replaced.

- 1. Disconnect the power cord from the socket.
- 2. Open the ChargerBox.

 See «4. Opening/closing the ChargerBox».
- 3. Replace the charger.
- 4. Make sure that both plug strips are switched on. The on/off switch (7, Fig. 2) is always in the "On" position.
- 5. Close the ChargerBox.

 See «4. Opening/closing the ChargerBox».
- 6. Reconnect the ChargerBox to the socket.

6. Maintenance

- Replace the ChargerBox if it is cracked/broken.
- ► Replace defective chargers. See «5. Replacing chargers».

Cleaning



Risk of damage!

- ▶ Do not clean with ultrasound.
- ▶ Do not sterilise in an autoclave.
- ▶ Do not machine wash.
- ► Clean the ChargerBox regularly with a cloth and a 50% isopropyl alcohol solution.

7. Disposal



Directive DEEE 2012/19/CE on electrical and electronic equipment waste

- ▶ Dispose of the package and the end-of-life product in an appropriate recycling facility.
- ▶ Do not discard the product with household waste.
- ▶ Do not burn the product.
- ► Remove the charger.
- Recycle the charger in compliance with legal requirements and do not discard with household waste.
